

## WA-GA-THA-KA Information and Policies - 2008

**Making Reservations:** We are pleased that you are considering WA-GA-THA-KA for your next stay in northern Minnesota! Because our availability information changes frequently, we do not post it on line. Instead, please call 763-420-4644 or email [kimaminer@yahoo.com](mailto:kimaminer@yahoo.com) for availability. Once we have confirmed your reservation we ask that you send in our signed **reservation form** along with your deposit in the form of check or money order to:

**Deposits:** All reservations require a \$200.00 deposit per cabin within 10 days of making your reservation.

**Cancellations:** We understand that plans change and guests may need to cancel. We hope you understand that an open week greatly impacts our short season. Therefore, deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable unless we are able re-rent the same week you had reserved.

**Additional Guests:** Rates include the number of people as stated for each cabin. An additional fee will be applied to each person exceeding that number. The additional person charge is \$25/day or \$100/week. We reserve the right to limit the number of additional people.

**Pets:** We believe dogs are a part of the family and are welcome at our resort for a \$50 per dog per week. They must have current shots and be well behaved. Renters are responsible for cleaning up after the dog in and around the cabin, beach and yard. Dogs must be leashed at all times and never be left unattended. Dogs are not allowed on the furniture or beds. Sorry, but no cats please!

**Boats:** One rowboat and dock slip is available with each cabin. If bringing your own boat, please check with the managers for exact dock location and boat landing procedures. We use the Wabana Lake public landing, which is just a few miles down the road from the resort. Free use of the paddleboat and canoe are included.

**Check-in and Check-out:** Please check-in at "The Lodge" when you arrive.

**Check-in is after 3:00pm**

**Check-out is before 10:00am**

Please observe these times so we can fully prepare for you and other guests.

**Quiet Hours:** 10:30pm - 8:00am

**Cabins:** Each cabin has fully equipped kitchens including a drip coffee maker and filters, toaster, microwave oven, fan and charcoal grill. Beds are complete with fresh linens, pillows, and blankets. All bathrooms have a shower with the exception of #5. Please bring your own kitchen and bath towels, soaps, special pans, paper products (toilet paper and paper towels), or any "can't do with outs". Please see our suggested **vacation checklist** for other packing suggestions. All cabins are non-smoking.

**Camping:** Our camping site is located on Little Wabana Lake just across the street from Wabana Lake. We do not have electrical hook-ups but campers do have use of showers and bathroom facilities as well as use of the resort swimming beach. Sorry, but we can not accommodate RV's.

**Supplies:** While we don't have a store on site, there are 2 convenience stores just a few miles down the road. Both carry groceries, gas and bait. There are also several large grocery stores in Grand Rapids which should be able to accommodate your needs.
